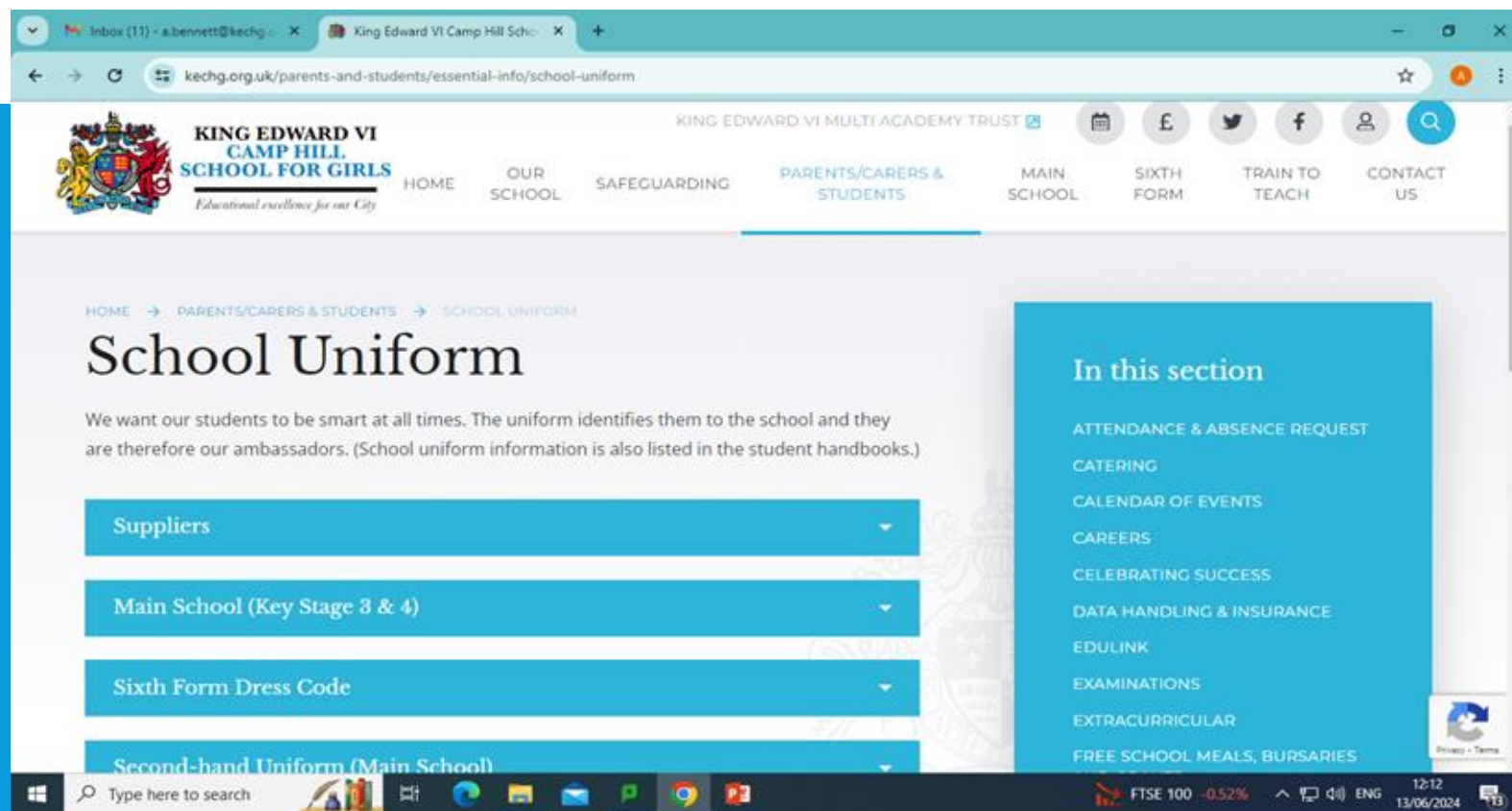

MOBILE PHONES

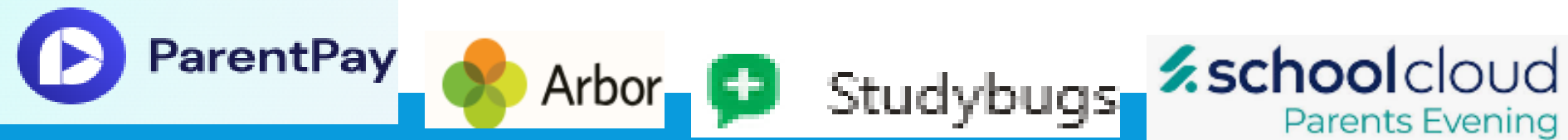
- ☆ Mobile phones should not be seen in the school building. If a student brings a phone it needs to be turned off and locked away in their locker for the duration of the school day.
