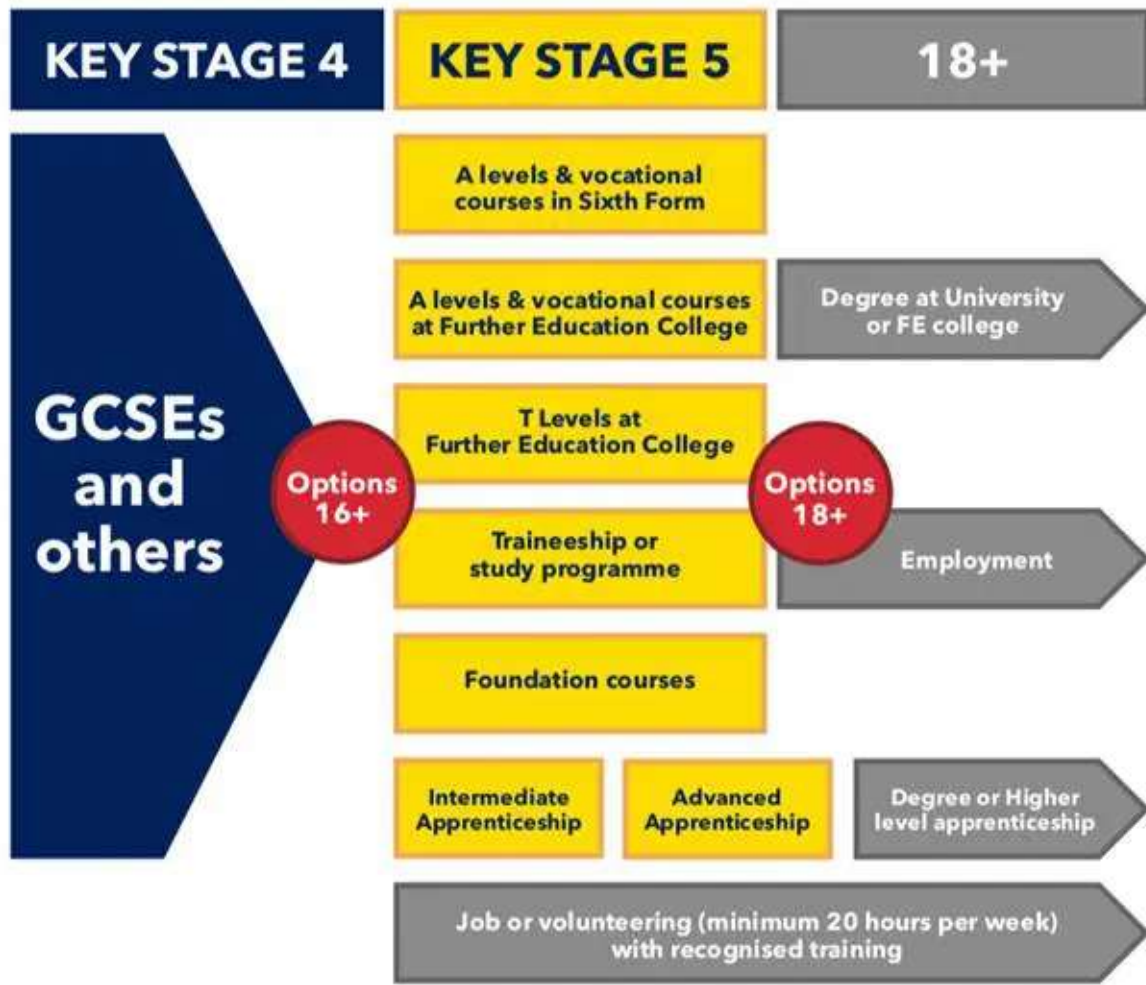
## Careers Activities in KS4
