## WHAT WE EXPECT FROM YOU

As there is considerable demand to join the Scheme we do ask that pupils and parents sign their acceptance of the following:

- Regular practice recommended 20 minutes daily up to grade 5 and 30 minutes daily grade 5 and beyond.
- Exemplary attendance at lessons. Please notify any problems in advance to Miss Hawthorne or the Instrumental Tutor.
- Purchase of music as required
- Committed membership of an ensemble as directed
- Attendance at concerts (see below)
- A half-term notice period for cancellation of tuition

#### **CONCERTS**


Concerts are given at least once a term and your daughter will be involved in at least 2 performances a year. Parents are encouraged to attend! We seat all our performers in the Hall to support each other and ask that they stay until the end of the concert (7-9.15pm usually). There is a nominal ticket price of £3 (£2 concessions) for audience members which helps to purchase ensemble music. Tickets are available on the door.
